Packing List

Note: Tools will be packed separately, one day prior to departure. Time & place TBA at August 2 (last) meeting

Important:

Pack 1 small day pack with 1 change of clothes, toiletries for stay at hotel on the way down.

It's a good idea to pack any prescriptions or medication in this pack, rather than in your other luggage.

Note: Your luggage will be towed separately and will not be accessible on the way down and back.

Luggage: We have limited space for luggage. Everyone is allowed 1 suitcase, plus your day pack, sleeping bag & pillow.

Sleeping bag or bedding (may be kept separate from suitcase) (they provide cots to sleep on)

Pillow (may be kept separate from suitcase)

2 Towels

Durable shoes you can work in. hard sole. No open toes/ no "crocks" on project sites.

Work gloves.

Hat

Tooth brush/shampoo/soap, basic toiletries (pack these in your day pack)

Flashlight

Water Bottle

Sunscreen

Bug Repellant

Sunglasses

Bible/journal/pen

Swimsuit (ladies, please wear a modest one piece)

Bandanas

Alarm clock

Sandals or shower shoes

Personal medications (pack in your day pack)

Work clothes (2-3 jeans or shorts, a few extra shirts, socks)

Comfort Clothes (2-3 outfits to wear after work around camp) (Note: You can do laundry during the week)

Snacks for the trip

Life Token
