One crucial step is collecting information in advance to identify potential risks. By receiving this information early, we can take additional measures to prevent incidents before they escalate. For example, potential threats to harm others or situations where someone may attempt to remove a child from the premises without authorization can be prevented when we work together.

Unfortunately, many incidents could have been avoided if someone had spoken up before they occurred. Often, there are warning signs, and if shared with the proper authorities, these incidents could have been prevented.

This is where we need your help. If you become aware of any situation that may pose a risk to those attending our worship services or events, we encourage you to share that information with the Leadership Team. Armed with this information, we can respond swiftly and appropriately to prevent harm.
